◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

Effective communication skills are paramount for successful leaders.

- If you invented an AI Computing Security Vault, but no one can understand how it works, what's the point?

Indeed, knowing also means knowing how to explain. Effectively conveying your ideas and innovations is an art.

This course covers topics such as “Media Speaking, Magical Presentations”, “TED Talk Practice”, “AI and Communication”, “Developing a Sense of Humor”, “Cures for Stage Fright”, “Group Presentations”, “Q&A Strategies”, “Storytelling Techniques”, “Hosting Skills”, “Cantonese and Expression”, and “Q&A Session Training”. We aim to provide comprehensive training in techniques, content, and mindset.
