Ignite Life Talk Series

This talk is one of the core programmes of the Leadership Training Programme Series. As one of the core programmes in the Leadership Training Programme Series 2025/26, this talk focuses on the theme of inclusion.

We are honoured to welcome Ms. Chan Cheuk-ki, Twiggy, as our speaker. Ms. Chan is the founder of Boaz International Education Institute and a former member of the Hong Kong Mental Health Advisory Council. Diagnosed with dyslexia at the age of 16, she experienced significant academic challenges during her childhood. Her turning point came when she met an inspiring teacher who helped her transform from a struggling student to one who excelled. Motivated by her personal journey, Ms. Chan later established an education centre to support students with similar learning difficulties. She firmly believes that "If the children do not learn the way we teach, we teach the way they learn." Her contributions have also been recognised, making her Awardees of the Children's Champion Award (Individual) 2024.

In this talk, Ms. Chan will share her personal experiences with dyslexia, the strategies she used to overcome these challenges, and her insights on how educators and peers can better support students with learning differences. Her story not only highlights the importance of inclusive education but also encourages future leaders to embrace empathy and adaptability in their leadership journey.
