Gifted Programme Introduction

Recently, the discovery of dinosaur fossils in Hong Kong has become a hot topic. But, how much do you know about the professional field of dinosaur behavior research?

In this course, we will unveil the mysteries of dinosaurs together!

In addition to learning about the world of dinosaurs, including their classification and the era they inhabited, students will explore the anatomy, habits, and ecological roles of various dinosaur species, fostering a deeper appreciation for their diversity. The course also introduces the key research methods and technologies used by palaeontologists to enhance students' understanding of and interest in palaeontology research. By the end of the course, students will be able to classify major dinosaur groups, describe their features and behaviors, and understand the scientific approaches in palaeontology.
