Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be ab.

- 1. use various methods to compute probabilities in appropriate ways;
- 2. recognize real-life activities related to probability;
- 3. apply various counting skills in solving practical problems;
- 4. explain basic concepts of probability and use them appropriately.

Gifted Programme Introduction

This course offers a comprehensive introduction to underwater archaeology, combining theory and practice to explore artefact restoration and heritage preservation. Students will study the development and achievements of Chinese underwater archaeology and learn fundamental concepts such as site formation, detection methods, and excavation techniques. Practical training includes underwater mapping, photography, and artefact drawing, providing hands-on experience with professional archaeological tools. Through real-world case studies, participants will deepen their appreciation of marine cultural heritage, strengthen their understanding of preservation principles, and cultivate a stronger awareness of cultural identity and national heritage responsibility.

The course consists of **THREE phases**. Selection for each phase will be based on students' performance. Phase 2 and Phase 3 are tentatively scheduled as below:

Phase 2: every Sat from 11 Apr 2026 to 14 Feb 2026 Phase 3: every Sat from 4 Jul 2026 to 5 Aug 2026
