## **Intended Learning Outcomes**

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. understand various chord progressions commonly used in popular music;
2. develop the ability to identify music genres;
3. enhance creativity by applying composition techniques to create melodies for different sections.

## ◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

This course is designed for young music enthusiasts, aiming to nurture students with musical potential. Through systematic training, the course enhances students' knowledge of music theory and composition techniques. It provides an in-depth analysis of the tonal characteristics of accompaniment instruments, such as the piano and guitar, helping students master the concept of instrumental arrangement.

Students will have the opportunity to use Digital Audio Workstations (DAW) to create their own original songs. They will experience the entire creative process, from conceptualizing melodies to practical arranging.

Focusing on interaction and hands-on practice, the course integrates key characteristics of popular music, empowering students to write compelling and melodious songs.
