## ◆ Suitable for

- S2 – S6 HKAGE student members in the 2025/26 school year. (Priority consideration will be given to HKAGE student members whose begin with 2430, admitted in the 2024/25 school year, then to 233 and 223 leadership students admitted in 2023/24 and 2022/23 through the Principal's Nomination)
- Class size: 60 Student members
  - 20 Experienced student ambassadors only by invitation
  - 40 new student ambassadors

## ◆ Participation and Selection Process

- New Student Ambassador would be selected through an interview. Only students who demonstrate genuine enthusiasm in their responses to the selection questions will be invited to participate in a Zoom interview for further selection.
