1. describe the foundations of social construction theory (SCT) and the acceptance and commitment therapy (ACT) framework, and explain how these approaches support personal and career development
2. apply mindfulness and act techniques to manage stress, uncertainty, and decision-making during their career planning process.
3. clarify and reflect on their core values, aligning academic and career choices with these values despite external expectations
4. cultivate a proactive and open-minded attitude towards exploring diverse career pathways and viewing challenges as opportunities for growth

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

This workshop, a core component of the Leadership Training Programme Series, is designed to deepen participants' understanding of career planning and essential life skills. By integrating Social Construction Theory (SCT) and Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT), the programme addresses the unique needs of gifted adolescents. Participants will learn to clarify personal values, manage challenging emotions, and make flexible, values-driven career choices. Through experiential activities, group discussions, and role-plays, students will acquire practical tools for goal setting, building resilience, and making informed decisions about their academic and career futures.
