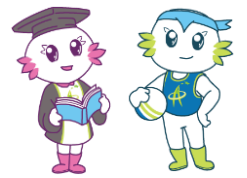

Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. explain why protecting local wildlife (e.g. amphibians and reptiles) and plants is important for a healthy environment;
2. compare and contrast the key features and habitats of common local species;
3. analyze the relationship between personal lifestyle and the natural world to reflect on the implications of ecological interconnectedness.

This fun course is led by professional eco-guides who take you into nature to become "Little Ecologists"! Through games and adventures, discover how these tiny creatures control pests and keep forests & wetlands healthy.

You'll also see how roads, pollution, and buildings threaten their homes.

Finally, learn easy actions: build insect hotels, cut plastic waste, use apps to identify & record wildlife — and become a Nature Conservation Ambassador!
