Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. Observe Sha Kok Estate on-site and use coloured pencils and watercolour to depict its landscapes and buildings;
2. Incorporate creative storytelling elements into their work to express personal feelings and imagination;
3. Master fundamental landscape and architectural drawing techniques to strengthen artistic expression;
4. Explore actively, share ideas, and collaborate with peers during the creative process, showcasing team spirit.

If student members withdraw from the programme after the Application Deadline, the token will be deducted.

Step Out of the Classroom – Discover Stories Hidden in Every Alley.

Join the five-day art creation camp organised by **Arts 101 (同創)**. Through observation and documentation of the community, you will bring the story of Sha Kok Estate to life with your own hands.

In this course, you will learn to document everyday life through art and add imagination to ordinary scenes. We will guide you in practising coloured pencil and watercolour techniques to depict buildings and streetscapes, and help you weave unique story elements into your artwork to sharpen your observation and creative thinking.

Let's explore on foot and tell stories with colour! By the end of the course, you will leave with inspiring artwork that captures the warmth and vitality of Sha Kok Estate as seen through your eyes.
