Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the gifted programme, gifted students should be able to:

1. identify the challenges faced by individuals with visual impairment in daily life and urban environment.
2. explain the key principles and approaches for designing inclusive and multi-sensory tour experiences.
3. recognise and advocate for social inclusion by promoting the integration of individuals with visual impairment into the community.

◆ Gifted Programme Introduction

CitySync: Inclusive Heritage Immersion Tour is an experiential learning programme designed to deepen participants' understanding of the lived experiences of individuals with visual impairment while fostering inclusive mindsets and practices. Through immersive activities and guided exploration, participants will gain insights into the challenges faced by the visual impairment community and examine how sensory perception shapes engagement with heritage and urban environments.

The programme emphasises the principles of inclusive and multi-sensory design, equipping participants with practical knowledge to create accessible and meaningful tour experiences. By integrating empathy-driven learning with real-world application, participants will explore ways to enhance participation and engagement for individuals with diverse needs.
