Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of this session of workshop, parents should be able to acquire skills to:

- 1. promote study related desirable habits (e.g. time management, setting goals, reading regularly, doing exercise);
- 2. promote some other desirable habits (e.g. expressing and regulating emotion, desirable thinking, meditation);
- 3. get rid of study related undesirable habits (e.g. procrastination, losing focus); and
- 4. get rid of other undesirable habits (e.g. losing temper, bragging, overly critical or argumentative, breaking promises easily, and poor attire and hygiene).



Introduction

This is the second workshop of a series of parent workshop with a purpose of exploring with parents practical ways and skills that their children need to recognize and acquire during the process of their whole person development. In this series of workshop, the instructor will give participants opportunities to share if their children have any difficulties in building desirable habits in life, and building desirable mindsets in life. Hence, the facilitator will enlighten the participants with useful ways or skills in promoting all those qualities mentioned, so that participants will know how to guide their children in enhancing those qualities in their whole person development journey.
